Motorists heading to the Soweto derby cautioned to obey all traffic rules

Pretoria: On Saturday, 30 January 2016, all roads will lead to the FBN stadium for the much – anticipated PSL Soweto derby game between Kaizer Chiefs and Orlando Pirates. Due to the nature of the game between the two teams, thousands of motor vehicles, mini bus taxis are expected to transport spectators from all different provinces to Gauteng.
