Tshwane Metro Police in court on corruption charges

Two Tshwane Metro Police officers are to appear in the Pretoria Commercial Crimes Court tomorrow on charges of kidnapping, robbery, extortion, defeating the ends of justice and corruption.

The two, a male and a female, were arrested when they arrived for duty at their Lyttelton offices yesterday. One of the suspects is believed to be a new recruit who completed training last year.

The arrest was effected by a collaborative team comprising of members of the Road Traffic Management Corporation's National Traffic Anti-Corruption Unit, the South African Police Service's Organised Crime Unit, the Tshwane Metro Police Internal Affairs Unit and the Gauteng Traffic Police Compliance Unit.

The officers were investigated following allegations that they had taken a motorist to the bank to withdraw bribe money.
