RECRUITMENT OF TRAFFIC TRAINEES PUT ON HOLD IN GAUTENG

GAUTENG-: The Road Traffic Management Corporation has placed the recruitment of traffic trainees in Gauteng on hold until further notice.

This follows challenges experienced at some centres where more people turned out than expected over the weekend. This high turnout, which was caused by gatecrashers who arrived uninvited, compelled the RTMC to halt the process for the safety of applicants that had gathered to be assessed.

Challenges were experiences at three of the seven venue that were used for the assessments. These venues were Edenvale, Ruimsig and Tshwane University of Technology.

Shortlisted applicants who were supposed to undertake their assessments at these venues will soon be contacted individually and advised of the new date on which the process will resume.

Media Statement

It is regrettable that the process that has had to be delayed causing inconvenience to

applicants. However, this has been done to ensure that legitimate applicants who have been

shortlisted are given the opportunity to undertake the assessment.

Stringent measures will be put in place when the process resumes ensuring that only

shortlisted applicants have access to the venues for assessment.

This does not affect candidates who have been assessed in other provinces and at Gauteng

centre where disruptions were not experienced.
