TWO SUSPECTS TO FACE COURT FOR POSSESSION OF STOLEN OFFICIAL LICENCING DOCUMENTS

PRETORIA: The National Traffic Anti-Corruption Unit has arrested two suspects in Temba, Hammanskraal on suspicion of involvement in the production of fake temporary driving licences.

The arrest followed information obtained by the unit from an informant who provided members with a fake temporary licence. Upon investigation, the unit members discovered the paper, on which the driving licence was printed, was part of official documents stolen during a business robbery at Alberton Registering Authority.

An operation was then conducted in Temba and the suspects were arrested when their vehicle was stopped and searched. Black temporary driving licence forms, a fraudulent driving licence, and a stamp purporting to be from Temba driver licence testing centre was also found in the vehicle.

The suspects have been detained at Temba police station pending investigation into allegations of fraud and possession of stolen documents. They will appear in court soon.
